Chadwick Boseman

Chadwick Aaron Boseman, was an African American film and television star. He achieved fame through his portrayal historical figures, James Brown, Thurgood Marshall and Jackie Robinson in major film productions, *Get On Up*, *Marshall* and *42* respectively. However, Boseman achieved international success for playing Marvel Comic superhero character T'Challa/Black Panther in the 2018 film *Black Panther*. Globally, the film grossed \$1.29 billion dollars, broke numerous box office records and was the highest-grossing film by a black director.

Boseman was born and raised in Anderson, South Carolina. He attended Howard University earning a degree in directing. One of his teachers at Howard was actress Phylicia Rashad who mentored Boseman. Rashad and actor Denzel Washington raised funds for Boseman and other students to attend a summer program at the British American Drama Academy in London, England. Upon returning to the U.S., Boseman began to write and direct. After graduating from the NY City Digital Film Academy, he had minor roles on several television dramas but landed a regular role on the series *Lincoln Heights*. Boseman starred in his first film, *The Express: The Ernie Davis Story* in 2008. Five years later he met success in the 2013 film *42*, portraying baseball pioneer Jackie Robinson.

Boseman quickly rose to notoriety amid a very active film career: between 2008 -2020, he had 15 movies. The world was stunned by his death on August 28, 2020 and the revelation he had been fighting colon cancer secretly since 2016.
